### Program Strand: Musical Theatre

Students who choose a career in Musical Theatre focus on acting, singing, and dancing. They learn: sight-singing, scene study, voice and movement for the stage, and styles of acting, as well as work in music theory, keyboard musicianship, stagecraft, history of theater (including American musical theater), and dance.
